- Treasurer's Report Shelly Casner we are at 76% of budget (284 members) for PTSA members and at 99% of parking budget
- Principal's Report Kindra Smith

Ms. Smith says Mr. Doherty works closely with Coach Mezzio and safety team. Safety update – 35 new door locks installed, sets off local alarm if doors are opened which lets school know who is coming and going from school and which doors are being utilized. Keychain tags if early arrival or late arrival to make sure they are

coming/going at the right time. Camera and 2 security officers and 2 cops – sergeant banks, officer Pinkey – at school all day – 4 people who are on campus all day. Mirrors on stair ways, and window blinds continue to make school safer. If you have suggestions send Mr. Doherty a short email with details because there is a budget for school to use for safety. Construction – new roof over auditorium, field is done, auditorium was renovated, and bathrooms will be updated. Lounge furniture in lobby will come but it is not a priority for now. Today is "Principal's List" – mini celebration for kids to sit with Ms. Smith and have ice cream at 11am, today (during meeting, event was changed to the following day, 9/14). For students who received straight A's during spring semester 2022. Kids get certificates, Honor roll – 85 and above – celebration is tomorrow, 9/14. Open house is tomorrow evening. Best start of the school year ever! Discipline is low. Referrals are low. Police presence helps, JROTC 115 kids are interested. JROTC is an elective class. Will be a bigger presence around school. Girls are killing it! Uniforms came in a few days ago. It takes a team effort. Paba, band, foundation everyone is making a difference. We are in this for all kids and must serve all to meet the needs of all. John Cribb is fantastic! Homecoming schedule external activities can impact the date of homecoming such as Sleepaway camp that had 150 kids, Young life event and Riverwood band event. Kids would miss this. Mr. Cage is responsible for scheduling date. Dance is on 10/22. Coach Mezzio is retiring at the end of this year.
